5.1 Appendix 1: SEE program	<p><b>Program Guidelines</b> The <i>SEE</i> program is intended to be a framework for Project Teams to build from and adapt to specific project needs. Student interns should be afforded the opportunity to engage with all participants within a Project Team but will be hired by a single host organization, who will be the employer for the student intern. The host organization may be either one of the business or federal partner participants. Specific company or organization/agency rules and procedures will govern the employment term up to a maximum of 18 months, which is the period of performance for the Round 5 project awards.</p>	<p><b>Program Guidelines</b> The <i>SEE</i> program is intended to be a framework for Project Teams to build from and adapt to specific project needs. Student interns should be afforded the opportunity to engage with <b><u>a wide span of</u></b> participants within a Project Team but will be hired by a <b><u>single organization (host organization)</u></b>, who will be the employer for the student intern. The host organization may be <u>any one of the project team's university, business, or federal partner participants.</u> <b><u>The student can be employed by any of the team members at any time throughout the duration of the project.</u></b> Specific <b><u>organization</u></b> rules and procedures will govern the employment term up to a maximum of 18 months, which is the period of performance for the Round 5 project awards. <b><u>The host organization is encouraged to work with an Ohio university through the university's internship/co-op office. Particular attention should be given to understanding the University guidelines for student payment and course credit.</u></b></p>
